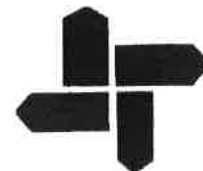

### Invitation for Bids

1. The Democratic Socialist Republic of Sri Lanka has signed a loan agreement with the OPEC Fund for International Development (OFID) towards the cost of the National Roads Improvement Project in Colombo District carried out by the Miscellaneous Foreign Aided Projects (MFAP) Division. Part of this loan will be used for payments under the contract named above.

2. The Road Development Authority ("the Employer") now invites separate sealed bids from eligible bidders for the Improvement of B239 Kottawa – Thalagala Road Section from Kottawa to – Thalagala (1+000 km – 15+480 km), which is in Colombo District. The construction duration for the package is 24 months.

The International Competitive Bidding will be conducted in accordance with Single Stage One Envelope Bidding Procedure with post qualification.

3. Eligible bidders must meet the following general & specific criteria:

- Pending Litigation shall not represent more than 50% of the bidder's net worth
- The bidders net worth within last 5 years shall be positive
- General experience in construction contracts within last five years
- Average annual construction turnover (AACT) within last 3 years, financial resources, and specific construction experience within last 7 yrs as given in the table below.

- Personnel: the bidder must demonstrate that he has the personnel for the following key positions for each project: (i) 1 Project Manager (Professionally Qualified Civil Engineer with 10 years total & minimum 5 years experience in similar work); (ii) 1 Material and Quality Control Technician (NDT or Equivalent with 8 years total & minimum 4 years experience in similar works). (iii) 2 site managers (NDT or Equivalent with 8 years total & minimum 4 years experience in similar works).
- Equipment: The Bidder must demonstrate the availability of key equipment listed below through presentation of proof of ownership or proof of intention to lease or rent with a provision that the equipment will remain on site as per the contract for each project.

- (i) Write to address above requesting the bidding document for the Contract Package No. RDA/MFAP/ICB/OFID-2/04, Improvement Roads in Colombo District under OFID – 2.
- (ii) Pay a non-refundable fee of Sri Lankan Rupees **(SLR) 27,000 (without VAT)** or **US \$ 205.00** by cash or bank draft in favour of the Miscellaneous Foreign Aided Project (MFAP) in respect of the bidding documents for each project.

The bidding documents will be issued during normal working days from **9.00 am to 3.00 pm** at the address under 5 above, from **03/02/2016** till **12/04/2016**.

7. Bidders should deliver:

- (ii) Together with a Bid Security in the amount as specified in the bidding document. For the purpose of determining the equivalent amount of the required Bid Security in a freely convertible currency, the selling exchange rates published by the Central Bank of Sri Lanka prevailing on the date 28 days prior to the deadline for Bid submission shall be applied.

Bids will be opened immediately after the deadline in the presence of bidders' representatives who choose to attend.

The bidder shall bear all costs associated with the preparation and submission of its Bids, and the Employer shall not be responsible or liable for those costs, regardless of the conduct or outcome of the bidding process.
